

SPECIES AVAILABLE

PARKSIDE FLOORING comes in four Australian traditional species - Queensland Spotted Gum, Ironbark (Red and Grey), Forest Red Species and Mixed Species Flooring.

SPOTTED GUM

A beautiful Queensland specie timber, botanically named *Corymbia Citriodora*, and is a unique blend of soft honey tones to rich reddish browns.

GREY and RED IRONBARK

Queensland Grey and Red Ironbark. The heartwood of Ironbark ranges from light grey or light chocolate with some darker reds and browns.

FOREST REDS

A rich blend of reds that range from reddish browns to soft salmon pinks. Predominately, Queensland Eucalypts, Forest Red Gum, Red Ironbark and Grey Gum.

MIXED BLEND

Mixed Hardwood is a mixed blend of Queensland lighter based coloured species, creating a variant range of colours.

* Hardness refers to the Janka rating which is the hardness level given to each species. The higher the number, the greater the hardness.

- **PARKSIDE FLOORING** includes a stunning range of tongue and groove solid timber flooring, and 14mm three lamella solid overlay.
- Timber Floors have an environmental impact which creates five times less carbon emissions than ceramic tiles.
- **PARKSIDE FLOORING** is easy to care for, once installed and sealed, your hardwood floor will look beautiful for years to come with just routine sweeping and maintenance.
- Quality **PARKSIDE FLOORS** are excellent for asthmatics and hayfever sufferers as they are not conducive to dust mites and other allergens.

EASY INSTALLATION

Once laid, **PARKSIDE FLOORING'S** superb qualities allows for traffic immediately, allowing other trades to apply their finishing touches before sanding and the final application of the desired finish.

PARKSIDE FLOORING tongue and groove boards widths up to 80mm can be secret nailed while boards 130mm are required to be top nailed as per the Australian Standard.

Timber flooring can be a do-it-yourself job as long as you understand your environment and correct installation practices.

Please note: Timber flooring is Hygroscopic which means that when conditions where the floor is laid become moist or dry, the timber will adjust to that environment.
