

PRE-OILED DECKING

Parkside Timber decking is now available pre-oiled to provide protection during the installation process.

Our decking products are grown and manufactured in Australia for Australian conditions. Our decking is certified by internationally recognised PEFC - guaranteeing that all products are sourced from sustainably managed forests.





KEY BENEFITS

- Pre-oiled decking means that all sides are coated providing protection during the installation process.
- Provides weather resistance and durability up to 8 weeks.
- Adds dimensional stability prior and during installation.

INSTALLATION

- Store in a cool dry area 100mm off the ground before installation
- Install decking 400mm off the ground, with good ventilation beneath
- Ensure good surface drainage below the deck
- Holes should be predrilled and countersink
- Joists should span a maximum of 450mm centre to centre
- Allow minimum of 3-5mm gap for 86mm and 7mm gap for 135mm
- Must be coated top side within 8 weeks of installation. Refer finishing instructions.

FINISHING INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. After installation, thoroughly scrub with a timber cleaner.
- 2. Once dry, apply 2-3 coats of selected oilbased or water-based timber finish. Do not apply a mineral oil based finish.
- 3. Conduct maintenance inspections annually to ensure your timber is repelling water and the finish is in sound condition.
- 4. If maintenance is required, thoroughly scrub with timber cleaner and apply selected finish.
